

# MT VisionAir X: Landing Sites in Swiss Mountains





## Radar Coverage: Widely Enhanced - East & South

The inclusion of additional radar ground stations improve coverage, especially to the east. The illumination reaches partly as far as the Urals and Black Sea to the south.

Sat Radar also improved in South West Europe, as well as i.g. for destination LXGB. Gibraltar as for LMML Malta International Airport.

Even "tricky" plannings get instant IFR routings.






## Heliswiss International Evaluates the Use of MT Systems in Chile
